- Canada has 1.3 million construction workers (8% of workforce).
- 500,000 of these workers are Building Trades Unions members.
- 4% of skilled construction trades workers in Canada are women.
- 300,000 workers will need to be recruited from outside of the construction industry to meet labour shortage requirements between now and 2025. <u>This is a huge</u> <u>opportunity!</u>
