Prestigious Lifetime Achievement Awards presented to two long-serving members

Halifax, Nova Scotia, June 5, 2026 – The Canadian Crane Rental Association (CCRA) honored two long-serving members: Alan Swagerman, Regional Manager – Crane at NORS Construction Equipment Canada, and Randy Moir, President of Moir Crane Service Ltd.

The awards were presented during the Closing Banquet of the CCRA Annual Conference, held June 2–4, 2026, in Halifax, Nova Scotia. The presentations took place on June 4 at the Westin Nova Scotian, in front of an audience of more than 230 industry peers and colleagues.

Alan Swagerman brings over 40 years of industry experience, having begun his career in 1985 with Irving Equipment Limited. Over the course of his career, he has held numerous leadership roles with Irving Equipment Limited, Sterling Crane, Mains Crane & Rigging, ENTREC, Mi-Jack Canada, and currently serves as Regional Manager – Crane at NORS Construction Equipment Canada. A dedicated contributor to the CCRA, Alan has served on the Board of Directors on three occasions, representing both crane rental members and supplier organizations. He was also a member of the Association’s founding Board of Directors in 1998.

Randy Moir is a fourth-generation owner and President of Moir Crane Service Ltd. He became a member of the CCRA in 1999 and served on the Board of Directors from 2001 to 2005, including as Chair in 2005. He later completed a second term from 2008 to 2011 and has remained actively engaged with the Association as a past Chair and Director.
